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#### The Athlete's Pledge

Individual and team success in sports results from personal commitment. The extent to which young student athletes are able to make such commitments reflects their maturity as well as their dedication to their family, friends, school, and team. Knowing that your coach has made a similar kind of commitment, we ask that you read and agree to the following pledge.

As a student athlete, I promise:

- To be a worthy representative of my teammates and coaches, abiding by community expectations and reflecting my team's values of commitment and hard work.
- To maintain my health and fitness levels.
- To reflect the knowledge that a commitment to victory is nothing without the commitment to hard work and practice.
- To attend every practice unless excused by the coach.
- To accept the shared responsibilities of team membership, such as cooperation, positive interaction, support of teammates, and mutual respect of others.
- To express my feelings and ideas intelligently and appropriately.
- To reflect the belief that true strength involves gentleness and that even the toughest student athlete is sensitive to others.

#### The Parent's Pledge

Cooperation among coaches, athletes, parents and the Brandywine Girls Softball League (BGSL) is essential if players are to realize the values of athletic participation. Like coaches and student athletes, parents must make commitments to any athletic program to assure cooperation. We ask that you read the following pledge, and as needed, discuss your reactions with your child's coach or an officer of the BGSL.

As a parent of a student athlete, I promise:

- To understand that all umpires' decisions are FINAL.
- To assist the coaches and umpires with self-policing of the sportsmanship code of conduct.
- To refrain from the use of any profanity or abusive language toward anyone connected to the game.
- To set an example of good sportsmanship for my child(ren) and all players.
- To make an effort to support the BGSL through fundraisers and work in the food stand.
- To keep the BGSL's property clean and report any damage or problems.
- To refrain from the use of tobacco products at the BGSL's games and functions.
- To NOT attend any of the BGSL's functions while under the influence or possession of any alcoholic beverages.
- To only offer positive comments toward ALL of the players.
- To privately discuss any concerns with the head coach immediately after games or practices.
- To assist in the spring clean-up, maintenance tasks, etc. when able.
- To remember that this game is for my child(ren), not for me.
- To support my child's efforts toward success.
- To assure that my child will attend all scheduled practices and athletic contests.
- To acknowledge the ultimate authority of the coach to determine strategy and player selection
- To work to promote a positive environment that is conducive to athletic development.
- To promote mature behavior from players and parents during athletic contests.
- To treat all coaching personnel with courtesy and respect, and insist that your child does the same.

I AGREE to these requirements. I also understand that if I fail to follow these rules and create an inappropriate situation for the children, I will receive only one warning from the BGSL. If after this warning I continue to disrupt any BGSL events, my child could be removed from her team and the BGSL. I also agree to hold any guest that I may bring to any of the BGSL's activities to these same standards.
